Today on the Senate floor, I introduced an amendment to expand Medicaid. This bipartisan legislation would provide much-needed healthcare to 130,000 working Kansans during one of the worst public health crises in our lifetimes. It would also keep taxpayer dollars here in Kansas as we face an uncertain economic landscape related to COVID-19.

Opposing Medicaid expansion has always been short-sighted. Now, it is indefensible.

That's exactly why Senate leadership immediately moved to shut down discussion. Their goal is to avoid debating this popular issue in the open because the majority of Kansans and legislators know expanding Medicaid makes sense. Ultimately, I was able to bring Medicaid expansion to the Senate floor for the first time this session. Unfortunately, some of my colleagues who support expanding Medicaid voted against discussion rather than stand up to legislative leadership.
